

KIMBRIDGE MEADOW FISHERY RULES

The Meadow Fishery is made up of four separate streams which you may wander freely around as we do not operate a beat system, however we do ask that you adhere to the following rules to maintain the current standard and thus providing enjoyment for everyone.

1. All rods must be in possession of a current Environment Agency fishing licence. This can be purchased by phone 0344 800 5386, from the Post Office or online at www.gov.uk/fishing-licences/buy-a-fishing-licence.
2. Rod sharing is not allowed.
3. Your ticket entitles you to enter the Fishery on the day of fishing only. The gate is opened at 8am and locked at dusk.
4. Upstream Dry Fly is preferred, although upstream nymphs maybe fished always casting at an identified Fish.
5. Bag limit 4 fish.
6. Please return all Wild Browns and any fish under two pounds.
7. Please avoid walking downstream into another angler's space. If you have no option, please take great care to keep well away from the fringe.
8. Please complete the returns book in the fishing hut.
9. Fishing off bridges and wading is strictly forbidden.
10. No keep nets to be used.
11. The fish farms are strictly out of bounds.
12. No Dogs allowed.
13. Please ensure all litter, including fish guts, are placed in the bin near the fishing hut.
14. No fires.

We reserve the right to ask anybody flouting these rules to leave the water.
